### POSITION SUMMARY

Crafters would facilitate a workshop or series of workshops teaching the basic skills of their trade in areas such as woodworking, pottery, scrap booking, art, sculpture, etc. to a small group of adults with developmental challenges.

Hours: 1-3 hour workshops at your convenience between the hours of 9-3 Monday through Friday.

Location: At your workshop/studio/ facility or 263 Pelham Rd. St. Catharines. Ideally the site would be fully accessible.

### RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES
